In terms of our finances, you will see from the Treasurer's Report we are in reasonable shape – thanks Des for your input and dedication to looking after the Club's finances. Also, congratulations on being nominated for Life Membership – a tremendous honour duly deserved.

The club facilities are still under review, the Board is currently considering proposals from Sports Medicos, Day-care operators and our current lessee – Derek Hume – Crosby's at Brothers.

With respect to the grounds, the training and warm-up facilities are currently being extended, the new areas will be filled, top soiled and seeded and will be ready for season 2005.

2005 is Brothers' Centenary Year – it will be a special year. Our events committee has been operating for some time under the chairmanship of Dick McGruther. Programmes are going into place and will involve kicking off the year with the Fish Festival (February); other events will include Team Reunions, Dinners, Back to Crosby events, traditional Brothers versus University match and much more. A Centenary Book – the 100 Years of Brothers, is being compiled. The Centenary Year will finish off with the tour to Argentina and Ireland.

In conclusion, I want to thank all members of the Board, players, coaches, managers, volunteers and supporters for all your hard work and dedication.

TEAM REPORTS 2004

Premier Grade 1

Played 19, Won 11, Lost 6, Byes 2 – 560 Points for, 373 Points Against 2004 SEMI-FINALISTS

In Premier Division grades A Grade made the finals for the first time in several years finishing the season in fourth position but losing the minor semi final to University. The season had started spectacularly for Brothers with victory in the preseason competition. This form was carried into the early competition rounds and Brothers headed the table for most of the first round before losses to Sunnybank and GPS at the end of the Round saw them slip down the ladder. The first round contained a memorable victory over the Gold Coast at Crosby Park. 46 - 17. Brothers remained strongly competitive throughout the second round losing only to Souths and Gold Coast before the final round against GPS. A loss in this game saw Brothers slip from second to fourth in a congested finals race. The lead in to the final round was less than ideal with the draw giving Brothers a split round bye followed by a club bye on consecutive weeks. The good early season form of Brothers was rewarded with the selection in the Queensland XV that played the Pacific Islanders at Ballymore. Regular A Graders Brendan Gabbett, Anthony Sauer, David Collis, Zane Hilton and Darren Murphy joined Reds regular David Croft in the team to bring Brothers representation to six. All of Brothers Queensland Reds made appearances for Brothers this year. David Croft was inspirational with his appearances for the club throughout the second round of competition. Sean Hardman contributed soundly but he was unfortunately limited in his appearances due to injury. Elton Flatley made a belated return for an appearance in the Brothers team for the minor semi final. The A Grade team missed a presence of club captain Dan Woolnough for much of the year due to injury. He was joined on the sidelines by centre Gerard Leydon latter in the season. This was a disappointing end to the year for Gerard after selection in the Australian University team provided a highlight earlier in the season.

Second Grade

The 2004 season was definitely a challenge for the Premier 2nd Grade.

The start of the season saw this team at full strength with strong competition for most positions. But, as is normal for this level, injuries within the Premiers and the team itself, soon saw severe depletion of key resources. Season 2004 was probably more affected than usual by the above-average injuries and losses sustained in the backline.

As a consequence, whilst it was pleasing to 'blood' some young 'tyros' in the backs for 2004, this produced mixed results due to lack of continuity and experience.

There were outstanding results early in the season and for the last game vs. GPS where the team won 50-10.

In all the forwards as a group had a steady year whilst the backline only occasionally reached its full potential.

Jordan Bennie, James Vail, youngsters Andrew Swain and Chris Mayhew and new-comer Peter Adams developed well, whilst club stalwart Andrew Cox had a good season that was sadly punctuated with injury concerns.

Joey Beckett played well above his weight and was usually one of the best players on the paddock. There were also solid contributions from Ben Canniffe (until walloped), Godfrey Esmonde, Dugald Asprey, Manney Riaz, Tau Siale and Todd Dammers.

Rohan Hoffman, back from Portugal, led this side with distinction and had a consolidating season which was unfortunately abbreviated due to work commitments. Most times, but unfortunately not enough times, John Gabbett, Teddy Ah Ben, Daniel Lavercombe and Doug Harrington had solid performances, as did Neil Hunt and Will Martel when free from injury. Tim Bryce, Blair Hart, Kieran Moffett, Sean Lynch and Bernie

McGovern had good introductions to this level of rugby. Amena Tuibua and Isikeli Rabai both contributed well in all of the many positions they were asked to play.

A tough grade, a tough season but a good learning experience for all.

The Coaches (Mayhew, Price, and Honan) and Manager (Woolnough) congratulate the team on their perseverance in the regime of constant change and lack of continuity that has to be accepted in this grade. Many of this year's team will become Premier grade players of the future.
